



2012 GRADING DATES & TIMES

All divisional teams are required to be graded every year to enable teams to play in divisions of teams, of similar skill levels. Grading, unfortunately, must take place in a very short window of time, approximately two weeks. Parents can help by encouraging players and their friends to register early (by the first weekend in February) and by having players attend all grading sessions.

It is the policy of this Club to re-grade players every year, so every junior player has the opportunity to progress. We ask that you trust our ability and honesty in selections. The word grading is used in reference to the placement of players into "like skilled" groups i.e. where they are conformable to play in. In competitive teams the selection of players will be the responsibility of the Director of Coaching, who may wish to keep training several more players that the team requires so as making his final selections as fair as possible.

The aim of the club is to grade the players as fairly as possible. Some parents place undue pressure on their children by expecting them to always be in the top team. We can suggest that parents help their children through the grading process by being supportive. Our request is that, in cases where is parent is in disagreement with the end result that they accept the final decision of the Club's officials.

Under 12 to 17 Grading - Player Responsibilities

- Spirit FC requests players to attend and grade in their correct age group.
- All players must be registered before attendance at the grading sessions.
- Players must also ensure footwear and shin pads are worn. Please bring a drink bottle.
- Every effort is to be made to attend all grading sessions for their age group.
- If additional grading days are required this will be advised to players by our Director of Coaching.

Please find listed below your child's grading date and time. We would appreciate it if your child arrives **at least 30 minutes before their scheduled time**, so that the coaches that are grading the players can organise them into groups and commence the grading process on time.

TENTATIVE DIVISIONAL TEAMS WILL BE ADVISED BY MONDAY 20 FEBRUARY FOR PRESEASON GAMES.

Preseason commences February to 18 March. Fixtures commence weekend of 13 April 2012.
